hooves. A quick check soon revealed a spirit attached to him. I led the soul, who'd died in a riding accident, to the other side, making sure they were met by a loved one.

But it wasn't the last time I found Zipper with a spooky new 'companion'. Apparently, Zipper saw himself as a bit of a healer. He'd 'host' spirits that had attached themselves to other horses in his field, knowing I'd be able to deal with them later.

It turned out to be good practice because I was soon noticing spirit attachments on other people's animals.

One time I was called out to heal a local horse using reiki. The horse shared a barn with a sheep – which turned out to have a spirit dog attached to it!

You see, all sorts of animals can be victims. Cats in particular pick up negative energy very easily.

If I feel an animal's owner might be spooked by me doing a spirit release in front of them, I allow the spirit to use me as a host so I can deal with it later, once I've left.

It can be unpleasant. Ninety per cent of attachments result from traumatic deaths, and I often experience the last thoughts and feelings the spirit had as they died.

A few years ago, a dog was brought to see me. He'd been in a car crash, and although physically unharmed, his behaviour had changed.

It turned out the accident had occurred at the exact same spot where another dog had died in a crash some time earlier – and its spirit had attached to this dog.

That's often the case with attachments. The spirit will attach to an animal or human it feels it has something in common with.

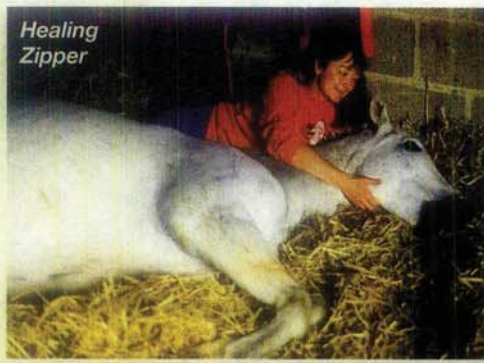
The spirit dog felt guilty he hadn't seen the accident coming and warned his owner, who'd been badly hurt.
